ORDINANCE #2008-15

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ANDOVER, COUNTY OF SUSSEX AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY ESTABLISHING SPEED LIMITS FOR BOTH DIRECTIONS OF TRAFFIC ALONG SUSSEX COUNTY ROUTE 616

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Committee of the Township of Andover finds it in the interest of public safety to establish speed limits for both directions of traffic along Sussex County Route 616 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-8; and

WHEREAS, the County Engineer will submit and certify all the legislative requirements pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-8 and the criteria as set forth by the New Jersey Department of Transportation, Bureau of Traffic Engineering and Investigations will be met; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Committee of the Township of Andover in the County of Sussex and in the State of New Jersey that speed limits for both directions of traffic along Sussex County Route 616 shall be established pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-8 under the County Engineer's Certification, Seal and License Number 21399 as follows:

Along Sussex County Route 616 for both directions of traffic:

Zone 1: 35 miles per hour from between the municipal boundary of the Town of Newton and Andover to Florence Lane,

Zone 2: 45 miles per hour between Florence Lane and a point 1,550 feet West of Limecrest Road a.k.a. CR 669,

Zone 3: 35 miles per hour between a point 1,550 feet West of Limecrest Road a.k.a. CR 669 and a point 2,800 feet East of Limecrest Road a.k.a. CR 669,

Zone 4: 45 miles per hour between a point 2,800 feet East of Limecrest Road a.k.a. CR 669 and the municipal boundary of Andover Township and Sparta Township,

School Zone: 30 miles per hour in the Florence Burd School Zone in Andover Township, within Zone 3, between a point 545 feet West of Current Drive and a point 617 feet East of Current Drive during recess or while children are going to or leaving school during opening or closing times; and,

Penalties: Every person convicted of a violation of any provision of this Ordinance or any supplement thereto shall be subject to penalty or imprisonment as expressly provided for by New Jersey Statute.

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed and this Ordinance shall take effect upon approval of a concurring resolution by the Sussex County Board of Chosen Freeholders in accordance with 39:4-197.2.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Committee of the Township of Andover finds it in the interest of public safety to establish speed limits for both directions of traffic along Sussex County Route 616 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-8; and

WHEREAS, the County Engineer will submit and certify all the legislative requirements pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-8 and the criteria as set forth by the New Jersey Department of Transportation, Bureau of Traffic Engineering and Investigations will be met; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Committee of the Township of Andover in the County of Sussex and in the State of New Jersey that speed limits for both directions of traffic along Sussex County Route 616 shall be established pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-8 under the County Engineer's Certification, Seal and License Number 21399 as follows:

Along Sussex County Route 616 for both directions of traffic:

Zone 1: 35 miles per hour from between the municipal boundary of the Town of Newton and Andover to Florence Lane,

Zone 2: 45 miles per hour between Florence Lane and a point 1,550 feet West of Limecrest Road a.k.a. CR 669,

Zone 3: 35 miles per hour between a point 1,550 feet West of Limecrest Road a.k.a. CR 669 and a point 2,800 feet East of Limecrest Road a.k.a. CR 669,

Zone 4: 45 miles per hour between a point 2,800 feet East of Limecrest Road a.k.a. CR 669 and the municipal boundary of Andover Township and Sparta Township,

School Zone: 30 miles per hour in the Florence Burd School Zone in Andover Township, within Zone 3, between a point 545 feet West of Current Drive and a point 617 feet East of Current Drive during recess or while children are going to or leaving school during opening or closing times; and,

Penalties: Every person convicted of a violation of any provision of this Ordinance or any supplement thereto shall be subject to penalty or imprisonment as expressly provided for by New Jersey Statute.

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed and this Ordinance shall take effect upon approval of a concurring resolution by the Sussex County Board of Chosen Freeholders in accordance with 39:4-197.2.
