ORDINANCE NO. 2014-10

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ANDOVER, COUNTY OF SUSSEX, AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY TO AMEND THE TOWNSHIP CODE BY AMENDING CHAPTER 3, "ADMINISTRATION OF GOVERNMENT," ARTICLE II, "ELECTIVE OFFICERS," TO ADD SECTION 3-5, "EMPLOYMENT RESTRICTIONS"

WHEREAS, elected officials of the Township of Andover are involved with voting on the award of contracts to vendors; and

WHEREAS, it is in the spirit of good government to avoid even the appearance of impropriety; and

WHEREAS, elected officials who have been a part of the governing body that awarded a contract to a vendor may not, for a period of one year, become employed by that vendor; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee has determined that this restriction is in the best interest of the Township.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Andover, in the County of Sussex, and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 3, "Administration of Government," Article II, "Elective Officers," of the Code of the Township of Andover, is hereby amended and supplemented to read as follows:

§3-5. Employment Restrictions.

No elected official who was a member of a governing body that authorized, or otherwise voted in favor of, the award of a contract between the Township of Andover and a vendor shall, for one year following separation from elected office, become employed by said vendor.

SECTION 2. All ordinances of the Township of Andover, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage, approval, and publication as required by law.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance may be renumbered for codification purposes.
